



MINORS DIVISION REGULAR SEASON LOCAL RULES

1. Home Team will keep Game Score and report score and pitch count to the Umpire.
2. Home team takes 3rd base dugout, visiting team has 1st base dugout.
3. **BOTH** teams are responsible for field set-up 1 hour prior to the game.
4. **BOTH** teams are responsible for dragging the field. Meetings to talk to your players should be done after dragging of the field
5. Each team to provide one new game ball, and one good used ball to the umpire, along with a lineup card.
6. **NO SLASH BUNTING IS ALLOWED**
7. NO player 11 years of age will be allowed to pitch or catch.
8. On weekend games, Home team takes a 10-minute infield practice 25 minutes prior to game time (If time permits).
Visiting team takes a 10-minute infield practice 15 minutes prior to game time (If time permits)

RULES & REGULATIONS

Baseball Rules: Little League rules and regulations will apply for all other circumstances not mentioned

- Playing Time
1. No player shall sit on the bench for more than one inning if there are substitutes available to play
 2. A player may play one position a maximum of two (2) innings per game.
 3. A Player can play the position of catcher a maximum of three (3) innings per game.
 4. A player man NOT play the position of catcher if he/she has played the position of pitcher, and has thrown 40 or more pitcher in a game

Batting Line-up: 1. Teams will bat through the order

Run Limits: 5 Runs Limit per Inning / No Open 6th inning

- Time Limits:
1. 2 Hour Drop-Dead Time Limit / games will be allowed to end in a tie.
 2. No new inning will start after 1 hour 50 minutes. If the inning is not completed, the score will revert back to last completed inning for game score.
 3. If the game being played counts towards standing or seeding, and the 2hr time limit has been reached before a regulation game has been completed (4 innings or 3 1/2 if home team ahead), the game will continue until a regulation game is completed.

Base Runners: Must slide or avoid defensive player when he has the ball and is ready to make a play
Failure to do so, in umpires determination could result in player being ejected from game. **NO SLIDING HEADFIRST, unless diving back to bag** ...player will be declared out!

Courtesy Runners: Courtesy Runner (local rule): If the batter gets on base and will be the catcher or pitcher for the next defensive inning, a courtesy runner can be used to speed up play. The courtesy runner will be the player who had made the previous out either in that inning or the previous inning (if the batter was the first of that inning).

Pitching Rules: Pitchers are allowed to throw a maximum of two (2) innings, not to exceed 75 pitches
No pitcher 11 years of age or older, will be allowed to pitch

Pitching Limit.

First Round (Jan 4 – Jan 22) Maximum of two (2) innings per game

Second Round (Jan 25 – Feb 12) Maximum of three (3) innings per game

Playoffs – We will follow Little League Baseball Tournament rules on pitching

Days of rest are as follows:

66 or more, four (4) days rest

51 to 65 pitchers, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed

36 to 50 pitches, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed

21 to 55 pitches, one(1) calendar day of rest must be observed

1 to 20 pitches, no rest is required.

Pitch counts will be sent to Kevin (kdub808@gmail.com), no later than the day after the game.

Breaking of Rules: Not adhering to the playing of pitch count rules will result in the following:
1. Warning
2. Suspension form the next scheduled game
3. Disciplinary action from the Little League Board
